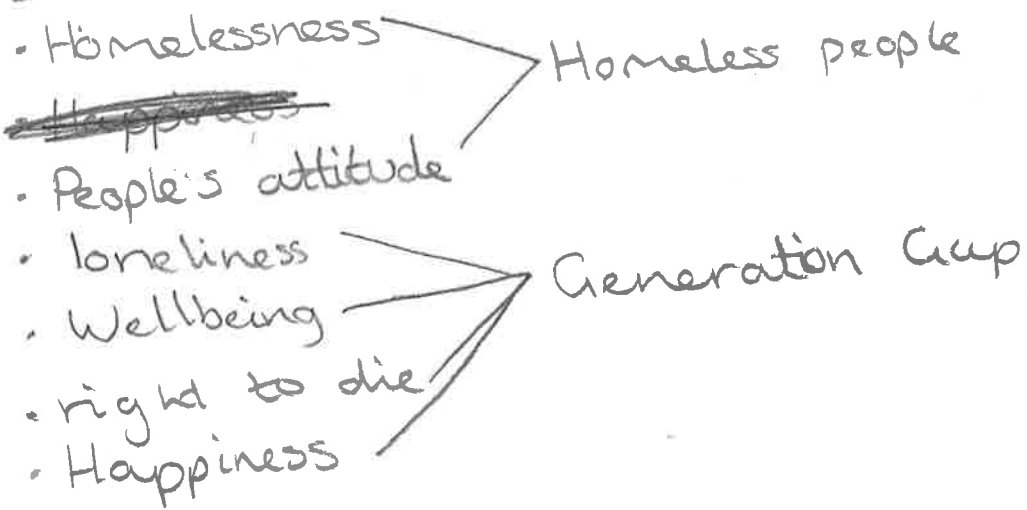
I learned things about homeless people and the old people's loneliness.
